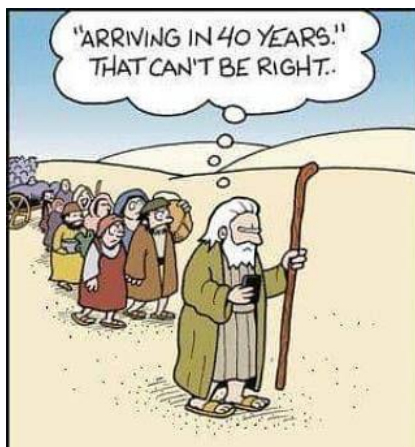
The puzzle is based on Luke 4:1-13 (NIV).
